A. Personal Statement

I am Associate professor at the Faculty of Medicine, Bar Ilan University, Tzfat and the founder and Director of the Institute of Human Genetics, Western Galilee Medical Center-Nahariya.

I obtained my MD cum laude in 1982 and board certified in Pediatrics (Israel) and Medical Genetics (Israel and the USA). Throughout my academic career my research focus is for the identification of the causative genes of rare genetic diseases. Of particular interest are Hereditary Spastic Paraparesis (HSP), Gray platelet syndrome (GPS), DNA repair defect syndromes and other neurogenetic disorders. In 2009 I was honored with the prestigious Visiting Professorship Award from the Feldman Family Foundation and visited the Department of Biology at Stanford University, where I and my colleagues were studying an array of research topics such as DNA repair mechanisms related to cancer and aging, and their related advanced technologies. I have been elected as the outstanding physician for the year 2009 at the Western Galilee Medical Center-Nahariya. I have published many scientific papers and reviews in various professional international Journals including in the field of cerebrotendinous xanthomatosis (CTX).

The genetic disorders we are testing for in the Institute of Human Genetics, though rare worldwide, are relatively frequent in the surrounding communities in Northern Israel, apparently due to founder novel mutations, and a high rate of consanguinity. This important project benefit has lead to the development of methods of genetic counseling tailored to Arab extended families (chamulas) at high risk for genetic

disorders and congenital birth defects, among them CTX. This service I am directing is aimed at

educating, preventing and minimizing the personal burden of birth defects and in several cases enabling treatment, which will prevent disease symptoms.
